In this course, participants will:

- Develop language skills in listening, reading, speaking and writing of Japanese.
- Gain confidence and broaden their knowledge of Japanese language, culture and society.



Japanese Plus is designed for adult learners interested in updating and refreshing their knowledge about Japan whilst practising their Japanese language skills in a series of evening classes at the Japan Foundation London. Whilst providing a genuine chance to look behind some of Japan's cultural issues, the course will also provide you with an ideal opportunity to improve all four skills of Japanese.

The participation fee for this course is £20.00, which includes all four sessions plus two free Japanese language newspapers. Payment must be made in advance or in person at the first session (23rd or 24th February), and cash only will be accepted.
