Second StepOutNet Training Session *Learning from recent Japanese taster lessons and sharing popular teaching ideas that work*

Last November, the JFLLC launched its StepOutNet School Visits Programme and ran the first training day designed for private tutors, teachers, volunteers and enthusiasts interested in delivering Japanese taster lessons at UK primary and secondary schools. Over 50 volunteers have since signed up as StepOutNet members - a number of school visits have taken place, and more lessons are due to be delivered by volunteers in the near future. This second free training session aims to give StepOutNet members the opportunity to find out how the first school visits went, how lessons were structured and what kind of resources were used and what the volunteers who delivered the lessons thought about the experience. The JFLLC is hoping to get more schools on board for a Japanese taster experience, and to give more volunteers a chance to deliver tasters at schools in their neighbourhood. Ideas for the near future include delivering Japanese tasters as part of the European Day of Languages on 26 September 2007 - an annual celebration of languages – including Japanese!
