The Second Speech Contest for University Students

Aims

The prime purpose of the event is to improve the speaking skills of students studying Japanese as a second language. Through this event, we hope to further promote Japanese language learning at Higher Education level in the UK and Ireland. The event has been organised by the Japan Foundation London Language Centre (JFLLC) and the British Association for Teaching Japanese as a Foreign Language (BATJ).

Outline

Eligibility: University students who are currently studying Japanese as a foreign language in the UK and Ireland.

Category 1: Those who are studying Japanese as a degree course or as part of a degree course with less than a total of 3 years' residence in Japan. Please note that those who have attended Japanese schools in Japan (e.g. nursery, primary and secondary schools) for more than 1 year do not qualify.

Category 2: Those who are currently studying Japanese for a non-degree course (i.e. an elective / optional course), and the total studying hours at university will not exceed 150 hours by 30th November 2006. Please note that those who have spent a total of 3 months or more in Japan do not qualify.

Candidates with Japanese parents are welcome to apply.

Procedure:

Candidates will undergo telephone interviews which will be recorded and evaluated. 5 candidates from each category will go through to the finals, **where they will deliver give a speech on one of three given themes**

The length of the speech in Category 1 will be 8-10 minutes followed by a 5 minute question and answer session.

For Category 2, it will be 6-8 minutes followed by a 3 minute question and answer session. There will be prizes for the winners and runners-up in both categories.
