## UCL-Japan Youth Challenge 2024

**The UCL-Japan Youth Challenge is a prestigious annual summer school programme.**

This programme was established in 2015 to celebrate the 150th anniversary of the Choshu Five<sup>1</sup> and the Satsuma 19 students<sup>2</sup>. They were the first Japanese students who studied at UCL (University College London). Upon return they played leading roles in modernising Japan. In this summer school, pre-university students from Japan and the UK attend a series of university-style lectures on a wide range of subjects by academics from UCL, and engage in UCL Grand Challenge Workshop, which aims to investigate one of the social issues in the world and explore solutions to it through discussion between Japanese and UK-based participants.

In the 10<sup>th</sup> year 2024, we hold our programme on campus in the UK, in three places: Rikkyo School in England, West Sussex; University of Cambridge, Cambridge; and UCL, London.

The UCL-Japan Youth Challenge 2024 is organised by the UCL-Japan Youth Challenge Committee.


## Why join us?

You must attend Days 1 and 4–8 (six days in total) regardless of your accommodation option.

Days 2 and 3: Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> and Monday 29<sup>th</sup> July are optional to attend if you are not staying at our Cambridge accommodation.

If you do not require UCL (University of London) accommodation, your last day on the programme is Day 8: Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> August.

If you stay at UCL (University of London) accommodation, you will check out on Day 9: Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> August.
