

New Japanese Art Crafts Exhibition to Open at British Museum

From the 19 July 2007 *Crafting Beauty in Modern Japan* will open at the British Museum to celebrate fifty years of the 'Japan Traditional Art Crafts Exhibition'. The exhibition, co-organised by the Japan Foundation, will display works created by leading Japanese artists, past and present, many of whom are designated 'Living National Treasures' and will be divided into six sections: ceramic, textile, lacquer, metal, wood and bamboo and other crafts.
